Sat June 18, 2011 **Fiber Dyeing** - Several dyeing techniques will be taught to make beautiful dyed raw alpaca fiber, yarns and rovings. Most of the dyed fiber will be used during upcoming fiber classes, but you will be able to take plenty of samples from the various techniques you learned/tried in class. Cost \$75 per person.

Sat Sept. 10, 2011 **Spinning Class** – This is a beginners level class to learn the basics about spinning and trying various spinning methods. Cost \$TBD per person.

All classes will start at 9 AM (coffee, crias and visiting will be ready at 8 AM) and will finish approximately 4 PM. A minimum of 5 people (and max of 10) will be necessary to hold the class.
